



## **Declaration on Conflict Minerals from The Democratic Republic of the Congo.**

*with regards to sec. 1502 of The Dodd-Frank Act.*

The term “conflict minerals” is defined as columbite-tantalite, also known as coltan (from which tantalum is derived); cassiterite (tin); gold; wolframite (tungsten); or their derivatives; or any other mineral or its derivatives determined by the Secretary of State to be financing conflict in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or an adjoining country.

As an integral part of our CSR activities, we work with our suppliers, seeking appropriate conflict free mineral declarations from them and their related to their supply chains – as a result of this due diligence to date, we can hereby confirm that the printed circuit boards we provide, have and will not be produced using any raw materials where the metals originate from the conflict areas as of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) or adjoining countries.
